

INCREDIBLE BUT TRUE! LITTLE KIDS SHOWCASE BIG SKILLS!

Imagine a boy in the KG class bringing his mother to the school and showcasing for an hour his language, numerical, motor, aesthetic and cognitive skills. Imagine, again, the mother exploiting that occasion to test him with an array of questions.

This was what happened at 'How We Learn' show organised by the Department of Pre-primary Classes at Everwin Vidhyashram and Everwin Matriculation Higher Secondary School on today (19.12.2015). About 4,200 kids from Pre-KG to Class II brought their parents to prove the power of their learning.

The show was a great success for it was the display of each child's learning outcome, and not just an exhibition. To the surprise of the parents, kg kids were performing activities like guessing the starting letter of a word; rearranging the jumbled letters; describing the objects given; performing math concepts practically solving puzzles etc.

Incredibly the LKG kids, just 5 months into learning, rearranged all the English alphabets – A to Z – with stunning ease. Similarly, kids could identify and say numbers, pictures, names of birds, animals, vehicles with words and letters. The catch was the way in which it was all puzzled and confused. But the kids felt very comfortable in answering all that to their parents.

Also, all activities the UKG, I and II kids do every day as part of 'power period activities' in the school were displayed. Students were called in batches along with their parents to attend the show. The parents were visibly overwhelmed and moved when they got to see children virtually pull them towards the displays.

The idea of parental assessment went well with the parents.

The objective of the show was to demonstrate to the parent community how powerful learning takes place in Everwin. Over 92% of the parents turned up.
